Part A: Implementation

As you implement your tool, check off each of the considerations below to ensure your tool appropriately meets the needs of students with varying abilities.

- Inclusivity and Equality:** Does your tool promote diversity, respect, and support for every student?

- IEPs and 504 Plans:** If applicable, does your tool support the services provided as outlined in the IEP/504 plan?

- Physical and Environmental Considerations:** How does your tool consider physical and environmental adaptations that your students may require?

- Learning Styles and Preferences:** Does your tool cater to diverse learning styles? For example, Auditory, Virtual, Kinesthetic, etc.

- Assistive Technology and Tools:** What tools can be integrated to empower students to access learning more effectively?

- Communication and Language Needs:** Is your tool accessible for bilingual learners?

- Behavioral and Emotional Support:** How does your tool foster positive behavioral and emotional (holistic) support?

Time Management and Scheduling: In what ways can your tool promote time on task skills?

Assessment and Evaluation Modifications: How does your tool incorporate various forms of assessment and evaluation?

Regular Review and Adaptation: How will your tool measure success?
